Dear Parent / Carer

The autumn term has started well and the children are settled and working hard in their respective classes, as we approach half term I thought it would be good to inform you of some developments and to clarify some dates.

School attendance is currently a little lower than the national attendance this is partly because of a sickness bug. We are reminding children to wash their hands (like we did during COVID) to prevent spreading germs. Please reinforce this message at home too so that we can get on top of the illness and stop it spreading further. The school website has an attendance page where there is a link to the current NHS advice re common illnesses. This is a good starting point for parents if your child is ill.

Whilst, on the topic of illness we are in the process of reviewing our management of medication policy and will update you after October half term with the changes. As a sneak preview we will be able to administer prescribed medication where the dose is three times a day, we will also be holding a secure stock of calpol/paracetamol and will ask you to complete a permission form so we can administer this if needed. This will mean that if your child had tooth ache (or similar) we will give you a call and administer the calpol with you permission. It will mean that you don't have to come to school to do so and we hope this is a change that you find useful.

One final think as a reminder; it was chilly this morning and there was a light frost. Please make sure your child has their coat and winter shoes when coming to school so that they are not cold at playtime.

Attendendance

A big thank you for sending your children to school every day possible; please keep this going in the lead up to the Christmas, so that our school attendance remains in line with or above the national average.

Reporting Absence

Please can you inform us via email or telephone before 9am if your child is going to be absent. You should report your child's absence everyday they are absent. If they have sickness and/or diarrhoea, they must remain at home for 48 hours after the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea. If you do not report your child's absence by 9.30am, it will be registered as an unauthorised absence. Please contact the school office if you have any queries.

Punctuality

Please remember that school starts at 8.50am and children should arrive by then to ensure that they are settled in class to start the school day. Children arriving after 9.05am will be registered as late and after 9.15am, unauthorised late.

Please park in the streets away from the school gates and the garages and walk the last little bit into school. Parking is becoming a concern and a health and safety risk, particularly at pick up time. We do not want to see any child or parent injured as a result of parking habits. Residents in School View have complained to the local council because vehicles are blocking access to their street. There will be parking wardens making random spot checks and handing fines out. Please help us keep your children safe by parking away from the gates, the garages and the narrow road to School View.
